

He believed God would spare his brother's life, and miraculously, the delivery room nurses were able to resuscitate the boy! Although they'd narrowly avoided one tragedy, Angel's mother had to leave her job to care for the new baby and the family struggled financially. Fernanda and her husband worried about Angel's well-being. "I had to quit my job, which had been providing extra income for the family. We did not know what we were going to feed Angel," she said.


